## SANTA BARBARA.

### A SUCCINCT AND RELIABLE SKETCH OF ITS DISCOVERY, RISE AND PROGRESS.

Away back in 1542 the "Santa Tomas", commanded by Cabrillo a Spanish navigator of renown dropped anchor off the shore where now rises the minarets and gilded towers of the channel city, after an uneventful passage from San Diego.

It was spring. As is usual in Santa Barbara there had been a good winter and the luxuriant foliage, the gorgeous wild flowers and the abundant evidence of natures kindly lavishness charmed the Spaniard's eye as it has charmed that of thousands since.

After the crew had been allowed an extra glass of grog and had sung the "Te Deum" it was decided to go fishing in honor of the gracious fate that had directed them to so charming a spot.

After fishing all day without getting a bite Captain Cabrillo got sulky. In vain his officers urged him to fish deeper or to change his bait. But Mr. Cabrillo said the place was not all it was cracked up to be and he was sorry he had discovered it anyway, and he guessed he'd go up and discover Lompoc.

And so amidst the unavailing protests of his officers and the grumbling of the crew the "Santa Tomas" braced away for the north, leaving Santa Barbara to bear the shame of his affront as best she could.

For 240 years after this no one came near the Channel City. Old Cabrillo lost no opportunity of slandering the place and always sent investors to San Diego or Monterey, where it has since been learned he had heavy property interests.

But one day nearly two centuries and a half later, Father Junipero Serra a Catholic preacher who had been holding a series of revival meetings along the coast arrived in town.

Father Serra took in the situation at a glance. His large experience told him that there was a permanent situation for the right man among the Barbrenas. With a zeal worthy of his meritorious undertaking he at once began the erection of a large mission.

While the work of erecting the mission was going on Father Serra went into the heart of Chinatown and hired the Opera House in which to hold his meetings. From this time to the present day Santa Barbara has steadily improved and has grown from a mere hamlet without railroad connections of any kind to a city, the beauty and healthfulness of which has made it famous wherever men get sick.

In 1848 at the conclusion of the Mexican war California was ceded to the United States. For a consideration of \$15,000,000 this city was thrown in and the United States has never regretted her purchase.

Santa Barbara shares with San Diego the distinction of hav-

ing the best brand of climate produced in the world. Winter is a word that the eastern visitor has to learn over again and summer is a poet's dream, whatever that is.

No city of its size in the country has better educational advantages and it would be difficult to find a more desirable place for a home.

Sportsmen find in the channel and in the mountain streams as good fishing as heart can wish and very often catch fish. Small game, such as quail, rabbits and other fowl abound in the foot hills and in the neighboring mountains bear, deer and panthers are to be had for the killing.
