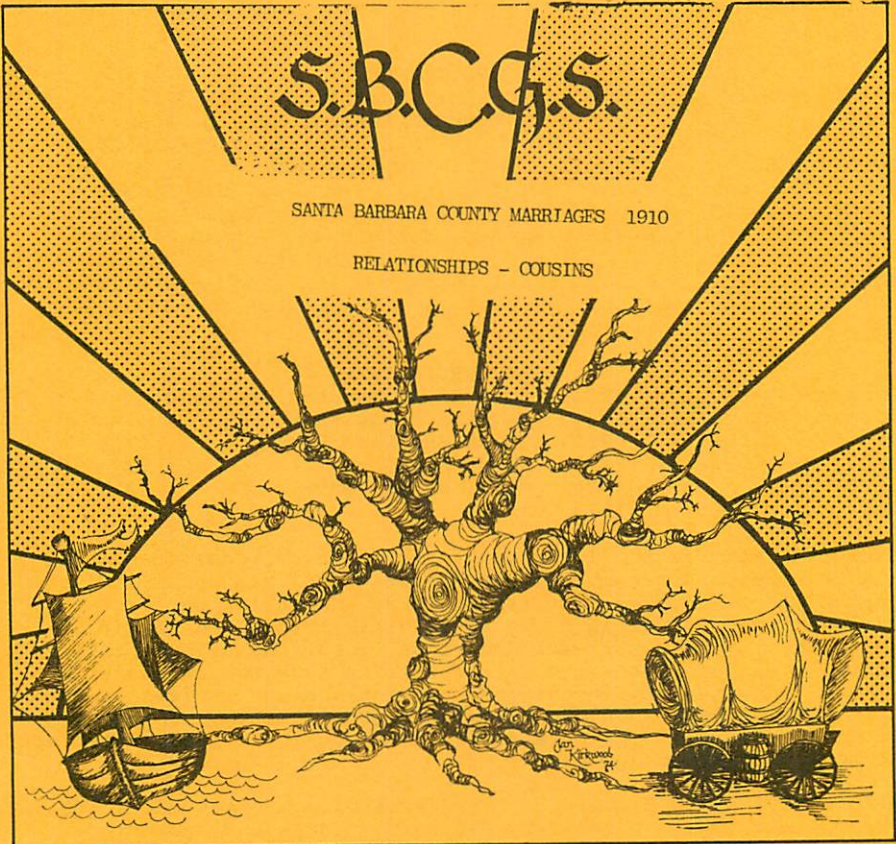

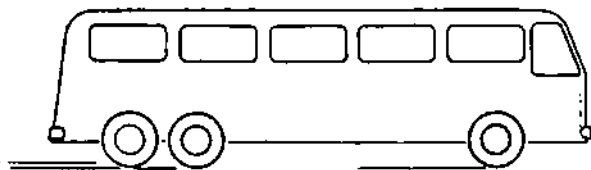

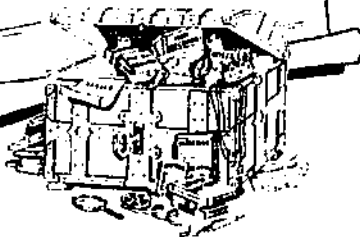

SUGGESTIONS FROM EXCHANGE PUBLICATIONS

THE ADAMS CO. GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY December 1984, p. 36 contains copy of an article in Oct. 1984 Newsletter of The Ohio Genealogical Society on ORIGINAL LAND PATENTS and includes:

"If you think your early Ohio ancestors may have received their Ohio lands from the U.S. Government, there is a simple way to find out for sure and - if they did- obtain a copy.

"The Auditor of the State of Ohio will search their index of land patents for free with a SASE required. Send your ancestor's name, possible location and date to: Auditor of the State of Ohio, P. O. Box 1140, Columbus, OH 43216.

"When you have received the information from the State of Ohio confirming that your ancestor did receive an original land patent, send all the information you received from the State of Ohio, along with \$4.25 to: Bureau of Land Management, Eastern States Office, 350 S. Pickett St., Alexandria, VA 22304. After you receive a copy of the original land patent, sometimes additional information may be obtained from the land entry files by writing to: General Branch (NNFG), Civil Archives Division, National archives & Records, Service (GSA), Washington DC 20409."

KANSAS VITAL STATISTICS CLOSED TO MOST based on an article from THE TOPEKA CAPITAL JOURNAL sent by Mrs. Marie Pierce of Osage City, Kan.

"State records of births, deaths and other vital statistics cannot generally be made available for genealogical study, Attorney General Robert T. Stephen said. Access to the state's vital statistics records is restricted by state law to people who need the records to determine personal or property rights... Executive director of the Kansas State Historical Society, Joseph W. Snell related this information after the Genealogical Society of Utah sent a proposal for a joint microfilming project."

July 1982 "DID YOU KNOW THAT?"

"Many of the settlers entering the Northwest Territory (what is now the states of Ohio, Indiana, Illinois) between 1810-1830 originated from the stocks of English, German, Irish, Scotch, Swiss, Swedish parentage but were almost entirely American born. European emigrants of those years filled their places in the Atlantic Seaboard states in areas of rising manufacturing industry."

YELLOWED PAGES, Vol. XIV, No. 3, Fall 1984 IMMIGRATION RECORDS

"We sometimes become annoyed because it is difficult to get an immigration record for an ancestor. But when we look at statistics, we find that between 1820 and 1972, the number of immigrants admitted from other countries to the U. S. is over 45 million. The largest number for a ten year period was 8,795,386 and it was between 1901 and 1910. The smallest number since 1830 was between 1931 and 1940: only 528,431 were admitted. The records for New York Port of entry for the years 1897 to 1902 are alphabetized. This work was done by the WPA workers, So if you have an ancestor arriving in those years, order a film from the LDS Branch Library for the name you want. It will show arrival date and name of vessel. With this information, you can order the ship records for the person from the U. S. Archives.

"The record gives much information on the immigrant. For instance, name, age, nativity, language, last permanent address, where going, name of the person they are going to in the U.S., amount of money they have, etc. (Most of them had \$12; this must have been the amount required.) It even tells by whom the passage was paid. Usually, self, but sometimes by Uncle, Brother, etc. When it tells where they are going, it gives name, relationship, and exact address. For instance, going to brother George Rabatin, 48 Washington Street, Yonkers, N.Y. This gives a clue to look up the 1900 census for the brother and find more family information."

Warning is made that places are as given in the text and are not or may be not correct. Rechecking spellings of town names and proper states is suggested before using the data in research. Each volume covers the text portion of the Gazetteers, but not the business directory. These index volumes are not just names and pages. The compilers have attempted to make them useful to a considerable degree without the Gazetteers themselves. They appear to be successful in this. In many instances the place of former residence is shown and in some instances later residences outside the area.

HOW TO DETERMINE RELATIONSHIP - COUSINS

Submitted by Audrey Guntermann

The Chart, which appears as a centerfold in this issue, illustrates the relationship between YOURSELF and a common ancestor. It could be extended indefinitely, Persons with a common GRANDFATHER are FIRST COUSINS. Persons with a common GREAT-GRANDFATHER are SECOND COUSINS. Persons with a common GREAT-GREAT-GRANDFATHER are THIRD COUSINS, etc.

In order to determine your degree of relationship to another descendant of a common ancestor:-

1. Determine the COMMON ANCESTOR, e.g. great-grandfather, great-great-grandfather, etc.
2. Determine how many generations you are from this ancestor (you are three generations from your great-grandfather).
3. Determine how many generations the other person is from the common ancestor. If he, too, is three generations from the common ancestor, he is your first cousin once removed (your father's first cousin). If he is four generations from the common ancestor, he is your second cousin once removed (the child of your second cousin).

There is an ambiguity in that "first cousin once removed" may be either your father's first cousin or your first cousin's child. These may be distinguished by "ascending" or "descending".

This chart may also be used to determine the relationship between ANY TWO DESCENDANTS of a common ancestor.

1. Determine the common ancestor of the two persons.
2. Determine the generation number of the parties nearest the ancestor, how many generation steps he is from the ancestor.
3. Determine the generation number of the second person in the same way.
4. SUBTRACT the smaller from the larger number. This determines the number of generations one person is removed from the other, e. g. $4 - 2 = 2$ Go to Row 2 in the table.
5. Now ADD the two generation numbers This determines the degree of relationship $2 + 4 = 6$. Go to Column No. 6.
6. Find the point where the Row No. and the Column No. meet and read off the exact relationship - 1st cousin 2 removed.

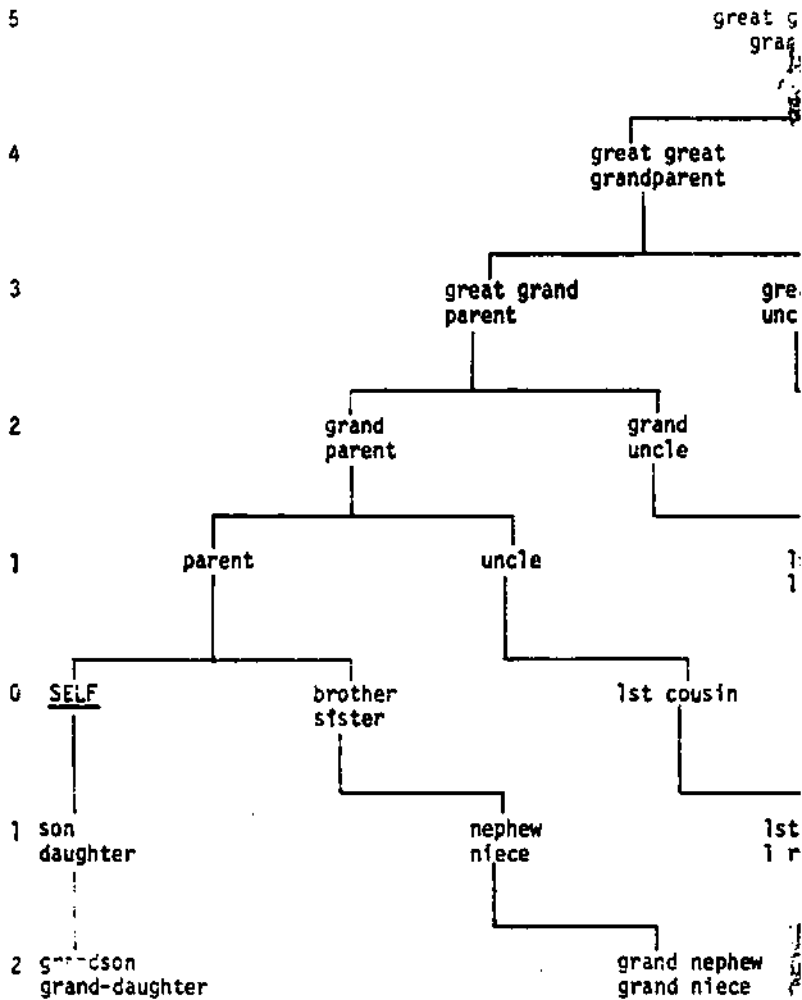

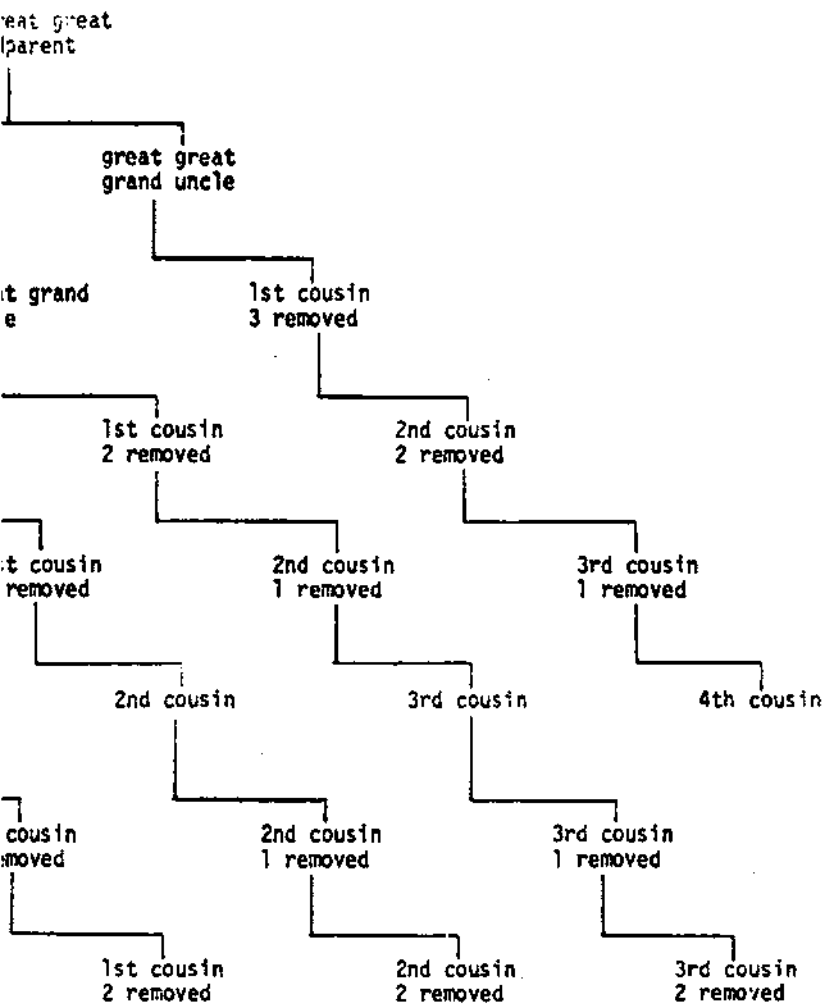

Ed. Note: In the case of some minors who married under the age of consent, the recorded licenses may show by whom the consent was given. Between the time that most of the transcriptions were checked and the time the editor returned to the County Recorder's office, the volumes had been removed from the shelves and put in storage in a downstairs vault and were unavailable. It would be possible to check the microfilmed records to obtain that information. In the future, except for 1911 and 1912 records which have already been transcribed and will appear in later issues of ANCESTORS WEST, all copying will be done from the microfilms. Member Virgini^a Paddock has volunteered to type the 1912 listings on her Xerox Memorywriter.

At the Los Angeles Central Library use of microfilm viewers is limited to one hour per time. More than that is too strenuous for the ordinary person's vision. So we should be increasingly grateful to the SBOGS members who so willingly undertake this timeconsuming and trying project. It is still the most important service rendered by SBOGS and ANCESTORS WEST.

SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

One of California's 27 original counties. While the county was actually created in 1850, the history of the area dates back to 1542. In that year Juan Cabrillo discovered the Santa Barbara Channel and later, according to legend crossed to San Miguel Island, where he died and was buried. A second Spanish explorer, Sebastian Vizcaino, entered the channel on the Feast Day of Saint Barbara in 1602 and named the area accordingly. Fr. Junipero Serra founded the Santa Barbara mission in 1786. Santa Barbara Royal Presidio, established April 21, 1782, was the last of four royal presidios in Alta California - San Diego, Monterey, San Francisco and Santa Barbara. Santa Barbara had all three Spanish forms - Presidio representing the military; Pueblo, civil and Mission, religious.

In 1873 Ventura County was established from the southern portion of the original Santa Barbara area.

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
