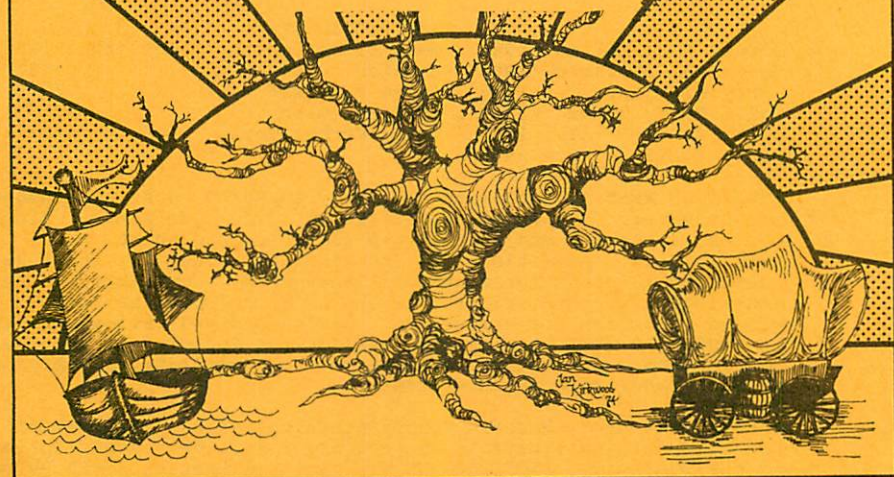

CENTURY CERTIFICATE

FAMILY HISTORY CERTIFICATE PROJECT of the Wisconsin State Genealogical Society, a statewide group interested in family tree research was launched in 1972 to award a PIONEER certificate to anyone whose ancestors settled in Wisconsin by 1850. And a century certificate to anyone whose ancestors settled in Wisconsin at least a century ago. This means that hundreds of descendants of early settlers can claim this CENTURY CERTIFICATE. In order to qualify, interested persons must be able to prove the ancestor's residency in Wisconsin by one official record, such as a census, a county history, birth or death record, land record. The claimant need not presently live in Wisconsin. Thousands of these attractive certificates, suitable for framing, have been issued since the project started in 1972.

CARL BOYER, 3rd. P.O. Box 333, Newhall, CA 91322-0333 on April 13, 1985 presented a most instructive and interesting lecture on GENEALOGICAL TOOLS AND INDEXING., including his own HOW TO PUBLISH AND MARKET YOUR FAMILY HISTORY, his revised Donald Lines Jacobus' INDEX TO GENEALOGICAL PERIODICALS, SHIPS PASSENGER LISTS AND ANCESTRAL LINES REVISED (190 families in England, Wales, Germany, New England, New York, New Jersey and Pennsylvania. He also supplied a Guide synopsis and extensive bibliographies. Books were available for purchase. The afternoon lecture dealt with IMMIGRATION AND PASSENGER LISTS.

CIVIL WAR DRAFT RECORDS

Newsletter, California State Genealogical Alliance, April 1985, pp 4-5/

Several months ago, Marty Hiatt, Los Angeles Regional Director, mentioned her quest for "Civil War Draft Records." This source is frequently mentioned in talks and in textbooks, but definite information on "how" to obtain such records is usually lacking.

Marty wanted to locate a specific place of birth for her ancestor Anthony Zimmerman. He did not serve in the Civil War and so no pension file is available for him. Since the Draft Records include all men ages 20 to 45 she felt this was an important source to check. All references indicated that to obtain the records the searcher must know the "Congressional District." No reference was found as to how to determine this information

I recommended that Marty contact Marcia Peura, a professional researcher in Washington, D.C. For a cost of \$10.00 Marty received a full listing of all volumes of Civil War Draft Records available for McDonough County, Illinois where her ancestor lived in the early 1860's, as well as a full listing for her ancestor's entry which reads in part "exempt physical disability Oct 28/64" thus explaining his non-service status. Unfortunately his place of birth was recorded as "Indiana" scratched out with "Germany" written above. Marty was able to locate the reference source needed to determine the Congressional District, and is currently pursuing the pertinent pages to make this source more available.

About the time Marty received her information, an excellent series of articles on these sources was published in the Tri-State Trader (Dec 1984 and Jan 1985). Some sample records are reproduced from those articles. Feeling that these sources may be of value to other Alliance members, I asked Marcia Peura to provide additional information. She indicated that the cost per page is \$8.55 per exposure, with a double page (most entries are double page entries) fitting on each exposure. She also provided further details on these records. Following information courtesy of Marcia Peura, CGRS, 4924 Schuyler Drive, Annandale, VA 22003.

"The Conscription Act was dated 8 May 1863. Therefore, there are no draft records before that date. The draft records consist of Consolidated Lists and Descriptive Rolls, which are mainly in large, bound volumes. They are arranged by the state and thereunder by enrollment districts (Congressional Districts). To access these records you must know the Congressional District. If you know the county in which the serviceman lived in 1863, you can find the Congressional District from the following:

CONGRESSIONAL DIRECTORY FOR THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 38th

CONGRESS OF THE USA (Washington: US House of Representatives, 1865)

At the National Archives, a copy of this publication is available in 8E (Old Military). Once you have the Congressional District, the appropriate ledgers will be pulled for you to view in the Central Research Room.

The Consolidated Lists are divided into three classes of men:

* men 20-35 and unmarried men 35-45 subject to military duty

* married men 35-45 * volunteers

Entries in each class are arranged alphabetically by the first letter of the surname. Each entry shows the following: *name * place of residence *age on 1 July 1863

*occupation * marital status *state, territory or country of birth

*if a volunteer, what military organizations he has served in

The arrangement for the Descriptive Rolls varies from district to district. Some are not indexed; some are indexed by the first letter of the surname; some are indexed by the place of residence. Each entry may show the following: *name *physical description * place of birth

* whether accepted or rejected for military service ? . . . Searches should be conducted in person or through a professional genealogist. . . .

SOUTHERN CLAIMS COMMISSION - INDEX

by Janice Gibson Cloud

Following the Civil War persons living in the southern states who had suffered loss of property could file a claim for reimbursement with the Federal Government. There were, however, strict requirements. The property must have been taken during daylight hours (necessary for positive identification of perpetrators) and the commanding officer and exact unit responsible must be named. Probably the most difficult qualification (for southerners, that is) was that the claimant must have remained loyal to the Federal Government throughout the war. Witnesses were required to substantiate this provision, as well as a sworn statement by the claimant himself. 22,298 cases were filed by individuals, family groups, churches, and businesses claiming damages of \$60,258,150. Ultimately, only 7,092 claims, amounting to \$4,636,929.69 withstood the rigorous and often absurdly rigid investigation.

The Commission followed a printed form when taking testimony and interesting family information can be learned if one is lucky enough to have ancestral ties to one of these claims.

The index to this record group is now in printed form (SOUTHERN CLAIMS COMMISSION 1871-1880 by Gary B. Mills, 1980) and available at the Los Angeles Public Library.

Information given in the following order:
Name; state; Commission#; Office #; Report #; year; amt. claimed; amt. allowed; amt. disallowed; barred, withdrawn, or dismissed; nature of claim.

CLOUD, Jerry T.; AL (Macon Col); 16371; 21; 4; 1874; \$2,530; -; \$2530; -; Horses, mules, ham, corn, and fodder.

Ed. Report: Jerry T. Cloud, above, is my husband's greatgrandfather, Jeremiah. I had found no record of his having served with the military during the Civil War. Then, one day while looking through the GUIDE TO GENEALOGICAL RESEARCH IN THE NATIONAL ARCHIVES, I came across the Southern Claims

Commission listing. On my next trip to Washington I tracked down the above index and decided to have a look at the records.

Easier said than done. The cases that were not "barred or disallowed" had been shifted several times to different jurisdictions. With each shift they had acquired a new identification number. Luckily, I had access to a free telephone and, after approximately 11 phone calls, was able to locate the present whereabouts of Jerry T. Cloud's file. Authorization to view the records was necessary and required about 3 more calls. The records were now housed at the Suitland, MD branch of the Archives, and after considerable discussion, a supervisor agreed to have them available the next day at a given hour (though they would have preferred several day's notice). The exact time was specified because I planned to take the free shuttle bus from the main Archives to the Suitland branch and would have exactly one hour there before the bus made its return trip.

The staff at Suitland was accomodating and had the file ready on an individual research table when I arrived. What treasure! From this record the following highlights are given.

Questions answered regarding loyalty:

Jerry T. Cloud states that he is 61 years old, a resident of La Place, Macon Co., AL and his occupation is farmer. From 1 April 1861 to 1 June 1865, he resided at the same place, on his own land, about 800 acres - approximately 450 cultivated, balance woodland. He did not leave AL during the war nor cross the lines. He was never threatened with damage or injury to his person, family or property on account of his Union sentiments. He sympathized with the Union and in 1860 voted for Bell and Everett and against succession candidates to the convention of that year. "I always felt that secession was one of the worst things that could take place and would produce civil war and that I had no confidence in it - that we could never have two governments on this continent. I just acquiesced after adoption of (the) ordinance of secession. My conduct before the state seceded was against the war and secession during the war. I tried to be quiet and do no thing one way or the other. I know of nothing that I ever did that would have prevented me from proving my loyalty to the Confederacy." (This statement, with those of

witnesses to his loyalty, was his undoing in the end.)

He had one son, Thomas, son-in-law A.G. Tuttle, and brother Dr. N.B. Cloud who served with the Confederacy, though he [Jerry T.] did not furnish them with any equipment, clothing, money, etc. "My son was about to be conscripted and volunteered."

Questions answered regarding loss:

Taken: 8 mules, five horses, all his hams - about 40 or 50 (weighing 15-20 lbs each), 40 or 50 bushels of corn, "I don't reckon (sic) over a 1000 pounds of fodder".

"I saw the articles taken by United States soldiers, forty or fifty of them, a lieutenant [Lewis] in command. They rode up to me and said, 'Here's a damned old secessionist' and I told them they were mistaken - and [they] went right at taking the property."

Loss occurred at La Place about 14 or 15 April 1865. Only other witnesses were 6 of his colored boys and 2 of this brother's [colored boys]. They were taken off along with the mules and horses.

Lt. Lewis ordered the property taken. "When I asked him how I was going to cultivate my crop, he said that was my look-out - that they were obliged to have the stock and provisions as they were subsisting on the country."

"My plantation was a mile or two off the main road. . .they camped around my place for two days. . .and hauled away about three wagonloads of fodder."

"The next day, three officers took breakfast at my house, and I was complaining to them that I was a union man and they said I would get pay for all my property taken."

"No voucher or receipt was given or asked for."

Cloud gives an evaluation of the property taken and ends this portion with his signature.

Testimony as to Loyalty of the Claimant:

Two witnesses, Frederick W. Williams (age 40 of La Place) and John A. Floyd (age 36 of La Place) give rather 'lukewarm' testimony to Cloud's loyalty.

Williams says, "I was absent during most of the war and couldn't say positively that I know his public reputation for loyalty, but he was called a union man." Floyd stated, "I never had no lengthy conversations about the war, but I have heard him, the first time I returned on furlough, say that it was all wrong - that we were too hasty in taking up arms and he talked against the war, and this was perhaps why we never had more conversations about the war. . .Mr. Cloud was looked upon as a strong union man for his strong action for Bell and Everett in 1860. Him and Moses K. Wheat were looked upon as particularly strong union men, not only at the commencement but during the entire war. . .I don't know of anything that he did or said that would have prevented him from proving his loyalty to the Confederacy if it had been maintained as a separate government except his conversations to me."

Testimony as to taking of property:

George Washington Cloud ("colored", age 45 of La Place) says that he used to belong to Mr. Cloud and that he now rents land from him. He was present and describes the raid.

The Commission investigated further and found that Jerry T. Cloud had purchased two \$500 Confederate bonds on 31 July 1863. 16 Sept. 1863, he purchased another two for a total value of \$1000.

In the end, Jerry T. Cloud's claim was rejected by the Commission with these remarks:

"The type of loyalty proved in this case is altogether too mild for our standard. Mr. Cloud is about 62 years of age. He resided in Macon Co. Ala. throughout the war. His son, son-in-law, and brother were in the Confederate Army. He was never threatened, molested, or injured on account of his Union sentiments. No acts of loyalty are found, and he says of himself 'I know of nothing that I ever did that would have prevented me from proving my loyalty to the Confederacy.' He did not 'adhere' to the Union cause and the claim is disallowed."

The original petition was submitted 30 July 1873. Jeremiah T. Cloud died in 1880 but S.C. Cloud, the administrator of J.T.'s estate, continued in correspondence with the Commission until 29 Aug. 1888.

ANCESTRY'S GUIDE TO RESEARCH, by Johni Carny and Arlene Eakle was intended to be a companion to THE SOURCE by the same authors and that it is. This guide is helpful to the beginner and the "not so new" researcher because of several features such as: detailed help in getting organized, how to gather and analyze evidence, tracing ancestors with common surnames, as well as special help in tracing female ancestors and those with possible military records. A long chapter that is a case study in Tracing an American Lineage step by step using hard-to-come-by records from the South is particularly helpful. Excellent maps showing major migration routes of New England and Southern Colonial families are a real aid as is a section dealing with the problems of The Frontier. BEFORE I WAS A GRANDPARENT, A GRANDPARENT'S BOOK OF MEMORIES, by Joann Colbert Beecher; Beechtree Press, ISBN 0-9613606-0-7, \$5.95

The book is designed to gather information about you, the grandparent, to present to a grandchild. The organization of the book might remind you of a baby-book. It has the same kind of format. There are places to mount special pictures, charts to fill in with family information and pages to fill with personal anecdotes and data. Each of the pages is titled and designed for fill-in or short sentences. There is a wide range of personal recollections: "things my father always used to say", "the most enormous difference between my childhood days and life today", and "which hobbies I enjoy". Family history spaces are provided for with topics such as: "This is how I met your Grandma/pa", "my home state is located", "my brothers and sisters and I used to", and "my child, your parent".

There are a number of topics to include in a biography that might not occur to the writer such as "my favorite pet", "places I traveled" and "my family's favorite holiday". These add very personal and affectionate touches to the book. Some of the pages of information might not be of interest to the grandparent; "these are my political convictions" and "my vocation has enriched my life by".

Objections to the book are that the tone is a little sweet. The pre-printed pages can be restricting. Here, the author recommends that you recreate the page by using your choices of pictures, newspaper clippings, etc. to cover the page in question. Overall, the ideas are good and useful. The book is successful because having gathered such a variety of information it presents a fully dimensional person to the grandchild.

SANTA BARBARA COUNTY



One of California's 27 original counties. While the county was actually created in 1850, the history of the area dates back to 1542. In that year Juan Cabrillo discovered the Santa Barbara Channel and later, according to legend he died and was buried. A second Spanish explorer, Sebastian Vizcaino entered the channel in 1602 and named the Saint Barbara and named the town accordingly. Fr. Junipero Serra founded the Santa Barbara Royal Presidio, established April 21, 1782, was the last of four royal presidios in Alta California - San Diego, Monterey, San Francisco and Santa Barbara. Santa Barbara had all three Spanish forms- Presidio representing the military; Pueblo, civil and Mission, religious. In 1873 Ventura County was established from the southern portion of the original Santa Barbara area.

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
